- When completing your forms, be sure to completely fill out your forms and have them signed. Make sure if you have an e-mail you put it here as this will be our primary way to connect with exhibitors. Make sure your parent's names are listed as you would like to see them in our sale catalog.
- **RFID** numbers will be closely looked at on all of our beef and feeder registration forms.
- We will need to have one picture of the entire animal **and a picture of the ear tag clearly visible** for each animal. You can include more than one picture per form. Staple pictures to the back of your form.
- **FAXED REGISTRATION FORMS WILL *NOT* BE ACCEPTED.** They will not provide photos and are difficult to read.
- Incomplete registration forms will ***NOT*** be accepted.

- My sale check will be mailed to my address listed on my fair entry form.
- This is not my entry form and I will need to complete that form by June 15 to be officially entered in the fair.
- I must use an ear tag purchased from the Gratiot County Fair for Youth office for each animal registered.
- I have read the rules for this species. (Current rules are printed on the back of this form.)
- The fair has up to eight weeks after the close of fair to mail sale checks.
- I must attach photograph(s) of each animal to this form. The photograph must show the body of the animal and the fair's ear tag with numbers clearly visible. If this can not be done in one photo, additional photo(s) must be added.
- I may only sell one animal at the large livestock sale.
- Forms not COMPLETELY filled out and with photographs attached will NOT be accepted.
- By completing this form, I agree to allow a GCFFY board member or Species Superintendent to do a visual farm check to verify information in this form. Refusal to allow this visit will result in disqualification.

2012 Market Feeder Class Rules

SECTION A - Feeder Market Class

- All Dairy Feeder animals must be tagged, photographed, and pre-registered with the MSU Extension Office by April 15.
- Feeders must be castrated, dehorned, and properly healed by fair entry (NO STAGS ALLOWED).
- If the animal has lost a GCFFY ear tag or RFID tag, the exhibitor must contact the office immediately and one of the superintendents or a fair board member will re-tag the animal. It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to re-take the animal's picture with the new ear tag in its ear.
- Dairy Feeder maximum weight at fair weigh-in will be 650 lbs. - All Dairy Feeders that weigh in above the maximum weight will be sold at the maximum weight and will not be allowed to compete for Grand or Reserve Champion.
- *Only* Holstein, Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Jersey, or red and white Holstein may show as a dairy feeder. Beef breed crossbreeding or crossbreeding with dairy breeds other than those listed above will NOT be eligible for Grand or Reserve Champion. Any protest must be filed by 6 p.m. Sunday with the superintendent and they will address the fair board. Fair board decision is final.
- Any feeder not qualifying because of weight or breed character will be allowed to show in showmanship and a market class, yet is not eligible for Grand or Reserve Champion. They will sell at the end of the sale.
- Classes are decided by the weight of the animal at the time of weigh in.

Changes and corrections may be made and will be printed in the fair book. Refer to fair book for official rules. If there are changes made after the printing of the fair book, the fair will contact each exhibitor who has registered with a market feeder animal.
