



PIG SCRAMBLE ENTRY FORM

Registration Deadline is June 15 at 4:00 p.m.

RULES

- Open to any interested boy or girl between the ages of 9-12 as of January 1 of the current year.
- Adequate facilities for caring for the pig must be provided.
- An application must be filled out with parent's signature and returned by June 15 to the MSU Extension Office.
- Participants must be a current year exhibitor of the GCFY.
- A scramble entry form may be downloaded from the website (www.gcfy.org) or picked up at the MSU Extension Office. A \$5 entry fee is required at the time of entry. Entries must be received at the MSU Extension Office by June 15. If June 15 falls on a weekend the deadline will be postponed until the next business day.
- Scramble pigs must leave fairgrounds by 8:00 p.m. on the night of the scramble.
- Record books will be provided to successful participants.
- Each participants pig will be inspected where they are being raised in the week of November 1 during the evenings. During inspection pig will be weighed, market price will be announced and record books will be picked up.
- If hogs are not inspected by a Gratiot County Young Farmer or record book is not completed, participants must pay the cost of one sponsorship (\$65.00).

My son or daughter may participate in the GCFY Pig Scramble and is an exhibitor at the Fair during the current year.
