Criteria for Senior Queen's Court Contest Participation:

- Between 14 & 18 years of age, as of January 1st, 2025
- Actively involved in the GCFFY for one or more years
- Has not previously won the Senior division
- Must be able to attend the upcoming GCFFY Opening Ceremonies, held the first day of the GCFFY
- Must be able to participate in royal court activities during fair week, including handing out ribbons, court photographs, etc.
 - Please be advised that photographs taken may be used at any time on the GCFFY website and Facebook page
- Must be able to participate in local parades and community events during the next year representing the GCFFY Queen's Court.

Must participate in the following to be eligible:

- Submit Application portfolio on or before the due date which includes:
 - Application questions (included in this packet)
 - Handwritten
 - Essay
 - Handwritten
 - At least one paragraph/five sentences long
 - Adult Recommendation Form
 - Completed by an adult/non-relative (included in this packet)
- Complete an interview with the judge's panel
 - Prepare for a professional style interview including business attire
- In addition to applicants' essay they will also be judged on:
 - Involvement in the Gratiot County Fair for Youth
 - Ability to represent the Gratiot County Fair for Youth positively
 - Personality and Attitude as represented in the interview

Application portfolios <u>are due by Friday May 23rd, 2025</u> at the FAIR OFFICE, located at the Gratiot County Fairgrounds. Applications can be mailed to: GCFFY, 701 S. Lincoln Avenue, Alma, MI 48801 or dropped off at the Fair Office at the above location. If the office is NOT open, there is a drop box located to the left of the front door. Applications mailed/dropped off elsewhere will not be accepted.

Queen's Court Interviews will take place on Wednesday, June 4th 2025, starting at 6:00 p.m. No makeup dates or times will be allowed.
